Here at the Ronald McDonald House of Cleveland (RMH), we love a good story. We have the amazing fortune to be surrounded by stories on a nightly basis — there are 37 guest rooms at RMH — and lately, we've been pretty full. In 2009, we've had over 97% occupancy, and our wait-list has sometimes grown to over 20 families. They come from around the corner, across the nation and around the world. Needless to say, each family has a unique story.

These families come to RMH for an affordable, comfortable place to rest while they deal with unimaginable adversity. However, many are unable to afford the \$20 nightly fee we request — especially as the current economic crisis has tightened everyone's wallets — and we never turn any family away, ever. **We need your help** to continue proving families a place to share stories, and create new ones.

We invite you to participate in the **8th Annual Tackle the Tower Stair Climb** on Saturday, February 6, 2010. This event is truly one-of-a-kind because participants don't run or walk, but climb up the 37 stories of the Tower at Erieview located at the Galleria!
