

2025 Race Participant Guide

Join Northeast Ohio's finest runners for this USATF-certified, point-to-point race along the scenic Rocky River Reservation of the Cleveland Metroparks. Established in 2000, this half marathon offers a smooth, relatively flat course, perfect for runners seeking a memorable experience from start to finish.

Event Overview

- Date: Sunday, September 7, 2025
- Location: Wallace Lake in Berea (Start) to Memorial Fields in Rocky River (Finish)
- **Distance:** Half Marathon 13.1 Miles (USATF Certified)
- Starts: Walk 7:00 am | Run 8:00 am
- Course: Slightly downhill, scenic, point-to-point route along Valley Parkway.
- **Time Limits:** Walkers (7:00 am start) 4 hours | Runners (8:00 am start) 3 hours. *Participants must maintain a 13:45 min/mile pace or faster for the Run Start*.

Registration & Pricing

- Online registration opened January 1, 2025
- Tiered pricing applies. Register early to secure the best rate.
 - o Tier 1 (1-100): \$65
 - o Tier 2 (101-300): \$75
 - o Tier 3 (301-500): \$85
 - o Tier 4 (501+): \$90
- Virtual Option: \$70
- Registration closes: Saturday, September 6 at 12:00 pm.
- Participants can pay by cash or check by filling out the paper form and mailing in to Hermes Office before Wednesday, September 3.

Packet Pickup

- No race-day packet pickup unless pre-purchased (\$12).

Race Morning Schedule

- 6:30 am Participants who selected Shuttle should be parked at Rocky River HS
- 6:45 am Shuttle leaves Rocky River HS for 8:00 am Wallace Lake Start
- 6:30-7:45 am Race-day packet pickup begins (paid option only) at Start Line
- 6:30-7:45 am Bag Check begins at Start Line
- 7:00 am Walk start (Wallace Lake)
- 7:30 am Valley Parkway closes to traffic
- 8:00 am Run start (Wallace Lake)
- 8:30 am Shuttle Service from RRHS to Finish Line begins for spectators
- 9:30 am Awards begin
- 10:00 am Shuttle service begins to Wallace Lake & Rocky River HS and runs continuously
- 11:00 am Course closes

Race Results

- Race results are posted live on RiverRunHalf.com race site, as runners finish.
- Split point timing mat is placed mid-way.

Bag Check

- A complimentary bag check will be located at the Start Line in the Fleet Feet Sports van.
- Your bags will be taken to the Finish Line in the same Fleet Feet Sports Van for pick up after you finish the race.
- Participants will need to bring their own bag, with their tear off bib tag attached to their bag (tear off bib tag can be found at the bottom of the participants race bib).

• Bags do not need to be clear.

Virtual Runners

- Available for those unable to attend in person
- Complete the half marathon anytime, outdoors or on a treadmill
- Times may be submitted online for recognition through September 28
- Packets can be picked up early at designated locations or will be mailed after the race
- Registrants transferring from the live event to virtual must pick up packets in person!

Rules & Restrictions

- No strollers or dogs allowed.
- Headphones allowed at low volume.
- Bibs must be worn on outermost clothing layer.
- Bibs must be worn by the participant it was assigned to runners will be disqualified from future races for wearing another participant's race bib.
- No cyclists on course.
- No pacers on course.
- No unregistered runners on course
- No late starters.
- No participants under 12 years old.
- Those who anticipate finishing over 3 hours must start with the 7am walk division.

Course Time Limit

For the safety of all participants and in coordination with city permits, the course will officially close at **11:00 AM**. This provides:

- 4 hours for walkers starting at 7:00 AM
- 3 hours for runners starting at 8:00 AM

- Participants who are unable to maintain pace within these limits should be aware that:
 - Course support, including traffic control and aid stations, may no longer be available
 - Roads will begin re-opening to traffic and participants may be directed to the all-purpose path
 - An official finish time, results, and finisher services may not be provided after the finish line closes at 11:00 AM

Refunds, Deferrals & Transfers

Transfer Options (choose one):

- To Virtual Run anywhere, anytime before Sept. 30, 2025 .Details: HERE
 - Those who transfer to Virtual will still need to pick up their race packet at packet pickup!
- To Another Runner Free option through RunSignUp <u>before final packet</u> <u>pickup</u>.
 - Bibs cannot be given away without completing the online process
 (violators may be disqualified from future races). Details: HERE
- To Another Hermes Race Transfer to one of these short distance races
 later in the year by Sept. 1 Details: HERE
 - Cleveland Turkey Trot (5K or 5-Mile, 11/27)
 - o Reindeer Run (5K, 12/13)

Deferrals

- Defer to the 2026 River Run for \$20 until Sept. 1.
- No deferrals accepted after this date.
- Deferrals are not available for 2027. Details: HERE

Refunds

• Like concerts or airline tickets, refunds are **not offered**.

• The River Run implements capped pricing at fair market value up until 1-day before the race to allow participants to register at their discretion.
